Report 1- 3/4/24 at 4.15pm

I was driving my car South on Ulnes Walton Lane, near Harrison's Farm. Travelling North was a cyclist, a white sign written work van overtook the cyclist, which was fine, however another work van with matching signwriting on then overtook the cyclist too and clearly hadn't seen me travelling in the opposite direction. He nearly knocked the cyclist off his bike and the cyclist shouted and waved his fist.

Meanwhile I was nearly forced into a deep sided ditch to my left.

It was a close call and I felt compelled to report it as it shook me up.

Report 2- 4/4/24 at 11.20am

I was driving my car north on Ulnes Walton Lane near the Southport Road end of the lane. I was following a farmer on his quad bike who was clearly unaware of me being behind him. Meanwhile there was a small black car behind me, tailgating me and he went to overtake me in an impatient manner but as he did the quad bike suddenly turned right without indicating and the small black car had to slam on.

Again another near miss that I would never normally report.
