


## Yarrow Valley Red Walk

## **Red Walk**

distance: **5.5 miles** time: **3 hours** 





- Leave the car park out of the Birkacre Road entrance and turn immediately left, crossing the bridge over the River Yarrow. On the other side of the bridge take the path on the right. Follow this footpath until it meets with New Road.
- Cross New Road and turn right heading downhill after approximately 20 metres take the path on your left (Sharratts Path), follow up hill.
- Sharratts Path ends when it meets Dob Brow, cross the road and turn right downhill. As the path rises turn left at the parking area into the meadows of Yarrow Valley.
- Follow informal paths through the meadow for approx. ¾ mile. Continue past the steps on the right, bear left following the path along the riverside. Cross a wide bridge and through a kissing gate before reaching Yarrow Farm.
- A marker post will direct you right following the eastern boundary of a field. Upon leaving the field continue through a wooded area and old quarry. Follow the path down some steps and across a plank bridge to a lane and turn right. After approx. 100m cross the River Yarrow and follow the path and onto Common Bank Lane.
- (6) At Common Bank Lane, turn left up the tarmac road.
- Follow Common Bank Lane round to the right, as the lane straightens out take a signposted path on the left and follow it.
- As you approach Euxton Woods you will come to a wooden stile. Here the path follows a circular route and can be followed in either direction, once completed you need to retrace your steps following the footpath back to Common Bank Lane.
