These hours are extended in the summer months and when events are taking place.





Follow these Directions



- 1** From the main car park head past the café and through the small car park. As you exit the car park turn right at the marker post up the track. Follow the track past 3 houses until the path widens.
- 2** There will be a kissing gate on your right and a path to the left. Take the path left through the gate. Follow the stone path.
- 3** At the second cross roads (benches on your left) take the path to the right heading towards the marker post. Stay on this footpath, past the methane burner and head towards the house.
- 4** Go through the gate and turn left on to the lane. At Burgh Hall Coach House bear left, turn right at the houses and up to the roundabout.
- 5** At the roundabout turn right and follow the road down to the road sign Burgh Lane South and Yew Tree Close. Turn left and then right at the way marker down Burgh Lane South.
- 6** Continue down Burgh Lane South, where the path forks take the right hand path and continue down to where the path takes a sharp right. At the next fork bear left and continue down towards the river and then turn right and continue until you reach the weir/ fish pass and take the steps down to the viewing area.
- 7** Turn right heading away from the weir / fish pass, go over the small bridge / sluice and bear left. Follow the path along the fenceline / hedgerow.
- 8** Where the path splits with a bridge to your left, keep right heading towards the Big Lodge. When at the Big Lodge follow the path left.
- 9** Where the path splits take the left path, go across the bridge and bear right past the play area. This will take you back to the main car park.
