



Chorley and South Ribble use of RIAMS by Public Protection Teams.

Position Statement

Summary

RIAMS provides Public Protection Officers at Both Chorley and South Ribble with Guidance for environmental health, housing and community safety services and supports them across all specialisms of environmental health to work smarter, network and share good practice.

It provides officers with reliable daily access to procedures, notice templates and guidance to support them in carrying out enforcement but also reassures experienced and new officers that they are following industry best practice within legislative framework, working consistently within the team and nationally.

Although it is recognised that the procedures provided in RIAMS represent best practice in some circumstances Chorley and South Ribble may not have the resources to meet timescales suggested within a procedure or the Authorities may not have adopted certain legislation meaning that the legislation suggested could not be enforced.

As an Authority we have recently started to verify a small percentage of work against the RIAMS procedures and some of the issues highlighted above have already been identified.

What has been agreed is that when such issues are identified a local context will be provided in the procedures explaining why we are not following the procedure to the letter.

It is recognised that because of the sheer number of procedures covering many different topics that it will take a long time to review all the procedures, but we will initially prioritise procedures that are used most by the Local Authority to be verified.
