(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES, CHORLEY) VARIATION ORDER 2025

Notice is hereby given that under the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, Chorley Borough Council ("the Council") has made the Chorley Borough Council (Off- Street Parking Places, Chorley) Variation Order 2025 the effect of which is:-

- To designate Hallgate, Ackhurst Lodge and Yarrow Park car parks as off-street long stay car parks 7 days a week with long stay tariffs in order to bring the car parks in line with other Chorley Borough Council long stay car parks.
- To designate Arley Street car park as an off-street long stay car park Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm, 9am to 1pm Saturday with a long stay tariff in order to bring the car park in line with other Chorley Borough Council long stay car parks.
- To designate Sandham Street car park as an off-street permit only car park 7 days a week. Eligible properties only and terms & conditions apply.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
