3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 7 May 2026.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday, 20 April 2026. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes, and amendments or cancellations of existing proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Chorley Borough Council, Town Hall, Market Street, CHORLEY, Lancashire, PR7 1DP by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, 21 April 2026. Applications to vote by post can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-postal-vote.
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, 28 April 2026, Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
