
## Your council tax bill explained



- 1 The financial year to which the bill applies.
- Your Council Tax account reference to help us deal with your enquiries more speedily, please use this reference if you contact us or make a payment.
- 3 The valuation band for your property.
- 4 People living in some parishes pay special expenses to Chorley Council for grass cutting and maintenance of open spaces. The amount you pay depends on the cost to maintain the area in your parish.
- 5 A breakdown of how your bill is made up.
- Where applicable, the percentage change to the Council Tax compared to the previous financial year.
- 7 This is a subtotal which is included in your overall bill.
- 8 Where applicable, any discount and/or Council Tax benefit that you have been granted. These are deducted from the annual charge.
- **9** The amount of Council Tax due for the period shown.
- **10** This is a barcode to make payment at a Post Office and PayPoint outlets.
- 11 How and when your Council Tax is payable. If you have opted to pay by direct debit you will not have to take any action.
- **12** Where applicable, any arrears of Council Tax outstanding for previous years. This may include any instalment(s) due.
- 13 How and where you can contact the Council.
- **14** The total amount of Council Tax that is due on your account.
