## **Notes**

- 1. The applicant is the organisation or person/s who intends to make use of the temporary structure.
- 2. The agent is any person acting on behalf of or as a contact person for the above organisation.
- 3. The location where the structure is to be erected.
- 4. Type of building, marquee, port-a-cabin, prefabricated building, air supported structure etc.
- 5. Size and layout of the building, a sketch of the layout is required showing means of escape, electrical equipment seating, stage, bar/food counter etc.
- 6. What is provision is to be made for toilet accommodation i.e. existing toilets to be made available or portable toilets to be installed.
- 7. Date of event and date that the structure can be inspected, usually the day before the event.
- 8. This form must be signed by the person responsible for the event. It is advisable for that person to read the Temporary Structures Guidance notes which are available from the Building Control section of Development and Regeneration Department

Please note that the proposal should cater for persons with disabilities and all electrical work proposed must be undertaken and certificated by a person competent to do so.
